**ORDER**

**AND NOW**, this 25th day of July, after a telephone conference today with counsel for both parties to discuss the plaintiffs’ motion for preliminary injunction (Doc. No. 7) and motion to expedite discovery (Doc. No. 8); and the parties having agreed that an evidentiary hearing is necessary to resolve the motion for preliminary injunction (Doc. 1. The motion to expedite discovery (Doc. No. 8) is **GRANTED**, and the parties shall proceed with discovery pursuant to the terms of this order;
2. The parties shall respond to and produce documents responsive to discovery requests by **August 5, 2016**;
3. The parties shall conduct depositions during the week of **August 8, 2016**;
4. The parties shall exchange any expert reports by **August 12, 2016**; and

5. The court will hold an evidentiary hearing regarding the plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction (Doc. No. 7) beginning on **August 16, 2016**, at **9:30 a.m.** at the Holmes Building, 101 Larry Holmes Drive, 4th Floor, Easton, Pennsylvania 18042.
